Q1: “What do you like about Cathedral Parish?”

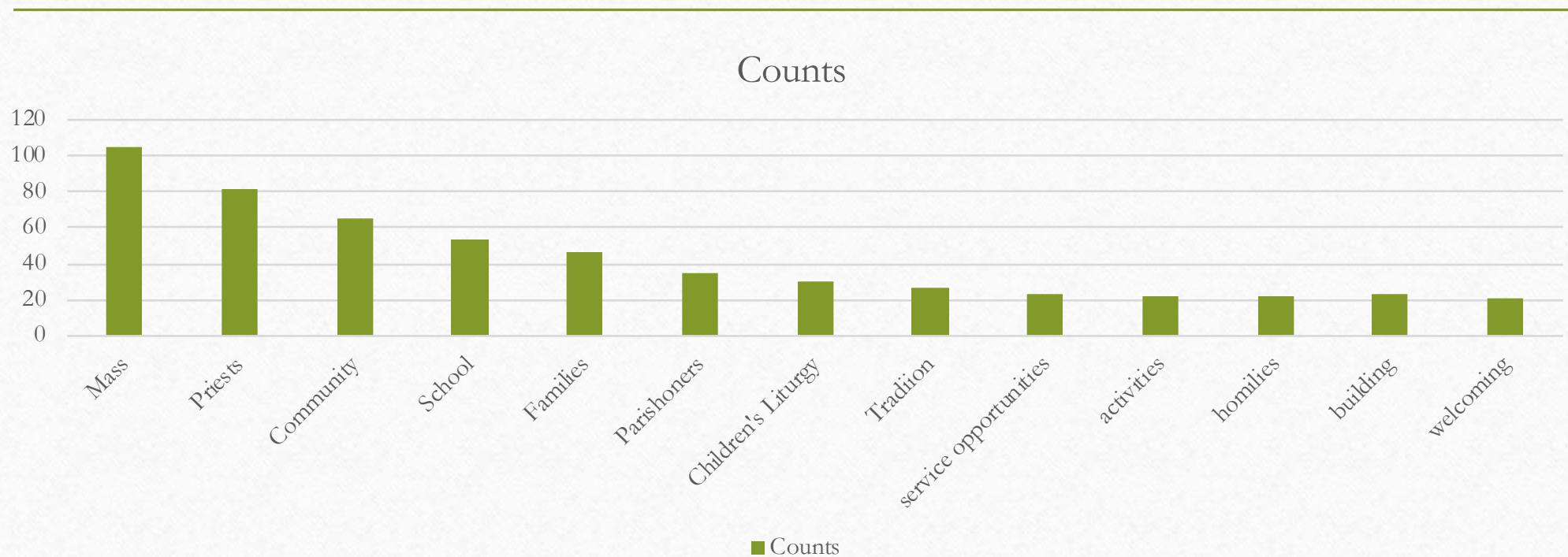

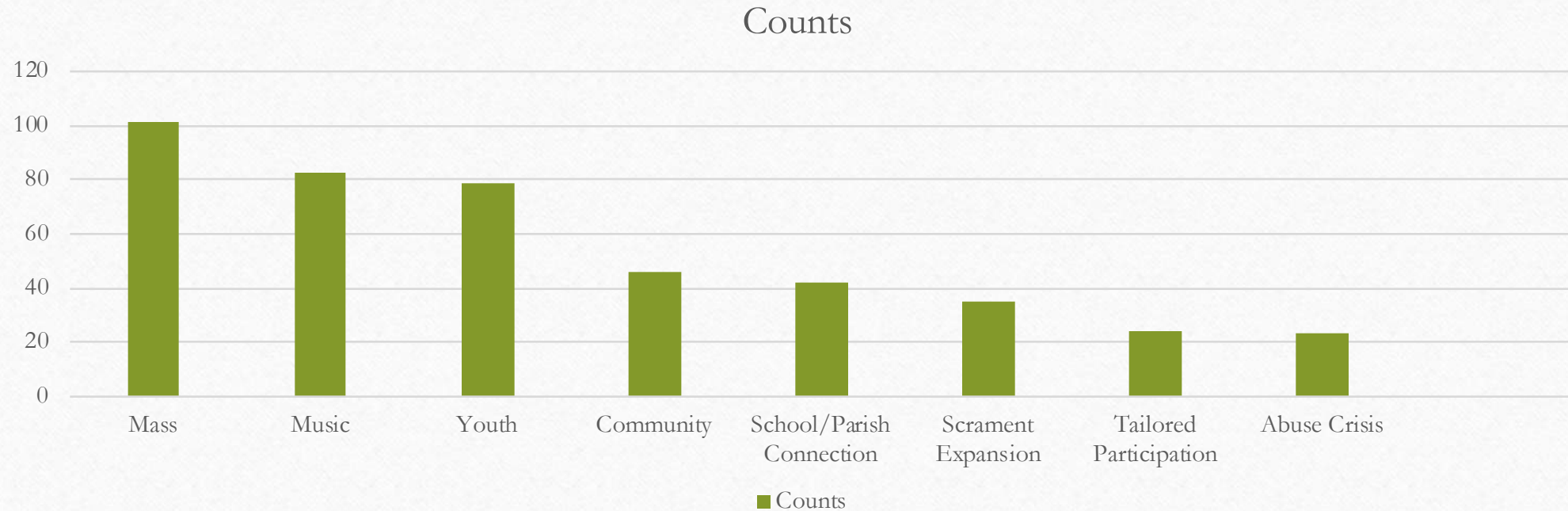
*Significant Theme Definitions

6. **Sacrament(s) Expansion** – Survey participants requested expanding or providing alternate times for confession; considering changes to Sunday schedule to include Sunday evening mass, and providing additional opportunities for adoration of the blessed sacrament. For all, provide clear information on availability in multiple formats.
7. **Tailored Participation** – Survey participants requested spiritual development, volunteer opportunities, and activities by life-stage and/or family structure.

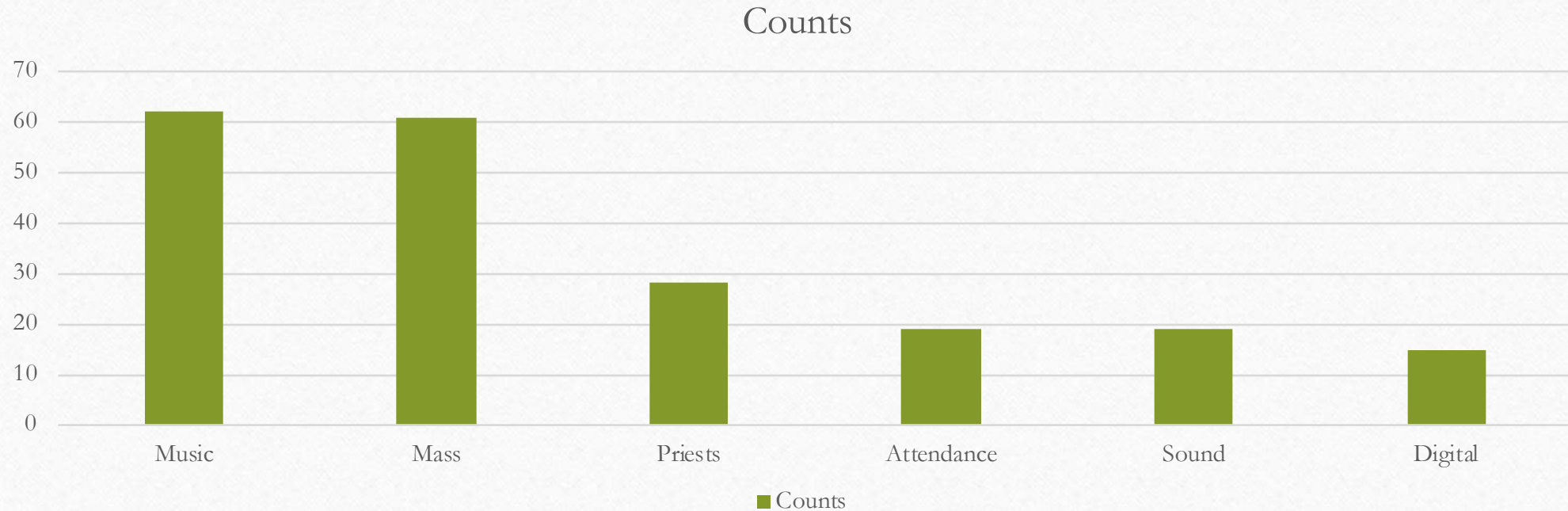

Significant Recommendations

- Accessibility- Reconsider handicapped parking and access; emergency access; digital and in-print sign-ups for activities and volunteering; Gluten Free hosts
- Coherence of Worship – Consider how to more thoughtfully and transparently integrate worship styles for Holy Days and larger/community wide services.
- Volunteer Coordinator –
 - Central lay person (with highly visible contact information) on parish staff responsible for soliciting, procedural/policy training, and placing volunteers across ministries (transparency, coherence in training) regardless of age or ministry. Training is visible, ongoing, and cyclic and should consist of VIRTUS in addition to CMOQ specific policy and procedures.
 - VC is a publicly identified as a mandated reporter.
 - Volunteers to receive ministry specific training from volunteer area following procedural/policy training and placement by VC.

Low-hanging Fruit

- Mass Format – Be more clear about times and what each service offers (style of worship, music, etc.) on web, bulletin, and other public facing documents.
